

Trees for Survival Planting Out Day **Gear List**



Thank you for your support with our tree planting and getting your child ready for the day on **Friday 12 August**.

All children will need:

- 'The Pinehill Way' in their pocket
- mufti clothes really suitable for outdoor work (track pants rather than jeans, longer shorts are ok if the day is not too cold, layers are good - children need to be warmly dressed but can then take a layer off if they get hot)
- personal wet weather gear (a raincoat with a hood is a must). This must be in their bag and not in an adult's bag
- a warm polar fleece, jersey or jacket
- headwear (a beanie for the cold, a sunhat for the sun)
- 2 bottles of water (one to drink, one to wash hands with)
- a small hand towel
- hand sanitiser
- morning tea and a good lunch
- a garden spade if you have one at home, named on the handle - not a shovel, not a trowel, **not** a child-sized spade. Gail (our TFS co-ordinator) supplies about 45 spades so please do not buy a spade especially for this trip.
- footwear [preferably gumboots] that can be worn in 'grubby/dirty', wet outdoor conditions
- a separate bag to put dirty gumboots in after our day of planting to keep the bus clean
- a second pair of shoes to wear on the bus ride to the farm, for the walk to the site and back to Pinehill afterwards
